5. President Report

The Provincial Government has contributed \$1.3 million dollars towards a Seniors Centre and the City of Vancouver is in receipt of the money. The Centre will be an addition to Killarney CC. We assume this contribution will bring the total of monies to date to \$3.8 million; we are awaiting confirmation of this from Councillor Raymond Louie. Although this contribution is gratefully received and is encouraging, we are looking to our MP Wai Young to secure a more significant Federal contribution.

- Activities during the past month included:
 - Attended meetings at SVNH, Killarney Community Association, Champlain Heights Community Association.
 - Met with MP Wai Young about senior's issues and federal contribution to seniors centre.
 - Attended a Forum with Coalition of HandiDart Users and ATU about transportation. 37,000 requests for HandiDart went unfilled last year.
 - Spoke to candidates about the need for seniors housing, home care for seniors and persons with disabilities, transportation and the Seniors Centre.
 - SVSACS members should visit both Gabriel Yiu and Suzanne Anton's campaign offices. **NDP** campaign office is at 6945 Victoria Drive across the street from 7-11 Store
 - Liberal** campaign office is in Killarney Mall about three doors West of Killarney Market. Be sure to identify yourself as SVSACS Member and ask for more provincial funding funding for the Seniors' Centre.

- BC Seniors' Guides in English and Punjabi were distributed to all Members.

6. Members Reports

Keith Jacobson spoke about the proposed seniors addition to Killarney. He reported that the city is seeking a contribution from the Federal Government, to top-up monies currently committed. This could only provide for a 7,500 sq. ft. addition that is totally inadequate. Our needs require a minimum 10,000 sq. ft. of new space with a separate elevator large enough to accommodate more than one wheel chair/motorized scooter. A new kitchen located within the Seniors Centre is also required. Air conditioning is a requisite as elders cannot withstand heat well which would render the upper floor unusable during summer months.

Joan Wright reported on SVNH/HUB and distributed a card with emergency numbers and a brief description of the Seniors HUB.
