4. President's Report:

Parks and Recreation convened Four Workshops. These took place on the 13, 20, 24 and 27 November 2014 to gather input from organizations and stakeholders. Only one report (for the Nov. 13, 2014 Workshop) has been received to date.

Glen Stokes, representing Carscadden Architects, was contracted by the Parks Department to facilitate these meetings, record input from participants and incorporate requests into preliminary drawings for the Seniors Centre. At these meetings, Mr. Stokes made it clear that his contract would end on December 31st, 2014. He stated, at the last meeting, that he had two weeks of frantic work ahead of him.

Parks Dept. scheduled a meeting for December 18th to review the preliminary drawings with the Building Committee to review the preliminary drawings. That meeting was cancelled by Parks Dept. Another meeting was scheduled by the Parks Department for January 8th and then cancelled by Parks Department saying that the work was not complete.

We don't know if it is the Bridging Consultant's work that is incomplete and his contract has been extended to complete it, or if it is some other part of the work that is holding up the design review process. It's hard to believe that nothing has been done since November 27th but there has been no further information. This is disturbing.

The completion date for our 10,000 sq ft Seniors Centre remains 2018 but with luck, maybe sooner.
