1. Call to Order – 10:00 am - Lorna Gibbs in the chair
2. Approval of Agenda - moved by Philip Mah, 2nd by Gail McKay, carried.
3. Approval of Minutes of Meeting 70 - moved by Bert Massiah, 2nd by Barbara Warner, carried.
4. **President's Report:** Lorna recognized Three members for their contributions to society:
Beatrice Ho has been appointed to the Mayor's Seniors Council and will bring our voice to that council and bring information back to us. **Mabel Leung** and **Eddy So** are organizing outreach celebrations to Chinese groups throughout the city. To date they have organized four events.
 - Lorna distributed copies of her report to the Killarney Community Centre association. The main point of the report was our motion asking that the kitchen be located in the Seniors Centre. Ainslie Kwan agreed to convey that information to the Park Board.
 - Lorna distributed the concept floor plan provided by the Bridging Consultant March 10. The kitchen has been moved to the main floor removing the need for a second elevator.
 - Old kitchen to be removed, adding 500 sq ft. to KCC room 203. The Seniors Centre will add about 9,860 sq. ft. An additional 310 sq feet for washrooms for sports field users will be provided under the 1st floor beneath the kitchen. (The Seniors Centre will close the current access from the north fields to washrooms). Total space added to Killarney CC may be 10,670 sq. ft.
 - Permit, CAC and DCL costs will also be charged to the budget. These fees are unknown at this time. A Public Hearing is also required.
 - Expressions of Interest Requests closed March 16, 2015. The City will qualify and select three from the respondents and ask for proposals. Only then will we get an indication of costs and amenities.

Generally, SVSACS Members were happy with the concept provided March 10.

5. Jennifer Mitchell and Bill Johnston from the **West Coast Railway Association** presented ***The History of Railway, The Royal Hudson and Train Travel.*** www.wcra.org - Their presentation was very interesting and well received. Membership is open to all. Highlights were:

- History of Railroading focused on BC; Association formed in 1961 dedicated to history and preservation of railroad stock. He outlined the advantages and benefits of Membership.

- Maintain the West Coast Railway Heritage Park in Squamish where the Royal Hudson is housed and other authentically restored rolling stock is on display. The Royal Hudson, a steam engine, was in service from 1940 to 1999. The park theme is a village circa 1920.
- The Society runs specialty trains at certain times of the year including the Dinosaur Train, Thomas The Tank Engine and in December the Polar Express.
- Locomotive 374 that pulled the 1st train into Vancouver on May 23, 1887 is on display at the Roundhouse Community Centre near the Canada Line station Yaletown-Roundhouse.
- Bill spoke of the challenges of raising money to restore and maintain historical artifacts.
- Volunteers, more always welcome, provide most of the help to staff and run their facilities. Jennifer outlined the tours available through their Tour Office. All profits go to the Society.
- *Magic & Totems of Haida Gwaii* a 10-day rail/ferry tour returning by air. Limited to 14.
- *White Pass & Yukon Spectacular* a 5-day air/coach/train tour.
- *Rocky Mountaineer* - three routes.
- *Historic Trains & Scenic Parks of Colorado Rockies* – 9 days.
- Several European rail tours
- Via Rail trains and Hudson Bay Heritage rail tour and Amtrack
