

What is Southeast Vancouver Seniors' Arts and Cultural Society?

Southeast Vancouver Seniors' Arts and Cultural Society (SVSACS) is a group of dedicated individuals working to have a seniors' centre built in Southeast Vancouver. The centre would house various arts and cultural activities for seniors, serving as a meeting and gathering place for the elderly of all ethnic backgrounds. The society developed out of the Victoria-Fraserview/Killarney and Sunset CityPlan Vision Implementation Seniors' Centre Subcommittee.

What does SVSACS do?

Our mandate is to:

- increase government awareness of the inequity in amenities for the Victoria, Fraserview, Killarney and Sunset communities
- create a feasible and sustainable business plan for a new centre
- work with federal, provincial and municipal governments to ensure a seniors' centre is created in Southeast Vancouver

Why is there a need for a new seniors' centre?

There are no stand-alone seniors' centres in all of East Vancouver! Southeast Vancouver's senior population was over 16,000 in 2005, and that number is growing fast. Currently, there is no place for seniors to call our own in Southeast Vancouver. Seniors need a place to meet, socialize, share a meal and most importantly, engage in stimulating programs of interest to our mature tastes.
